### FOGGING SCHEDULE FOR 17<sup>TH</sup> - 19<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2021

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to advise the general public that as part of its mosquito control programme for the adult *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, the Insect Vector Control Unit will be conducting fogging operations in the following areas commencing at **5:00 pm** daily on the island of St. Vincent.

**Tuesday, 17<sup>th</sup> August 2021** – Largo Height, Rillian Hill, Glen Side, Owia & Orange Hill

**Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> August 2021** – Old Montrose, Chauncey, Yambou, Owia, Noel, Magum & Overland

**Thursday, 19<sup>th</sup> August 2021** – Paul's Lot, Vermont, Queenbury, Carrierre, Point & London

Please take note of the following:

- Home and business owners in the named areas are reminded to keep their windows and doors open to allow the fog to take effect.
- Motorists are kindly asked to take caution.
- Persons who are suffering from any respiratory illnesses are kindly asked to take the necessary precautionary measures.
- Residents are also encouraged to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in their yard and to protect themselves from mosquito bites during the day.
- Please note adverse weather conditions can affect fogging operations.
