### FOGGING SCHEDULE FOR 9<sup>TH</sup> - 12<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2021

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to advise the general public that as part of its mosquito control programme for the adult *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, the Insect Vector Control Unit will be conducting fogging operations in the following areas commencing at **5:00 pm** daily on the island of St. Vincent.

**Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> July 2021** – Campden Park, Belair, Georgetown and Indian Bay

**Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> July 2021** – Campden Park, Gomea, Chilli and Villa

**Wednesday, 11<sup>th</sup> July 2021** – Questelles, Gomea, Caratal and Villa

**Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> July 2021** – Rillian Hill, Pilgrim Hill, Kelbourney, Spring (G'town) and Villa

Please take note of the following:

- Home and business owners in the named areas are reminded to keep their windows and doors open to allow the fog to take effect.
- Motorists are kindly asked to take caution.
- Persons who are suffering from any respiratory illnesses are kindly asked to take the necessary precautionary measures.
- Residents are also encouraged to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in their yard and to protect themselves from mosquito bites during the day.
- Please note adverse weather conditions can affect fogging operations.
