NO NEW COVID-19 CASES IN SVG

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to inform the general public that based on results received from the Public Health Lab at CARPHA, Port of Spain, Trinidad at 7:38 this evening, there are no new COVID-19 cases in St. Vincent and the Grenadines.

To date 31 persons have been tested for COVID-19, with 34 swabs being done. Results for 30 persons have been received, with 1 positive result that of our index case on March 11, 2020. One result remains outstanding.

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment urges the general public to adhere to the advice provided on hand washing hygiene, physical (social) distancing and to the quarantine requirement for **ALL** persons who have recently travelled from the USA, Canada, the United Kingdom and the European Union including Martinique and Guadeloupe.

The Ministry will continue to provide the public with additional information as it becomes available.
