### **FOGGING SCHEDULE FOR 20<sup>TH</sup> - 23<sup>RD</sup> SEPTEMBER 2021**

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to advise the general public that as part of its mosquito control programme for the adult *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, the Insect Vector Control Unit will be conducting fogging operations in the following areas commencing at **5:00 pm** daily on the island of St. Vincent.

**Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> September 2021** - Belair, Chauncy, Calder, Bohomme, Chester Cottage & Simon

**Tuesday, 21<sup>st</sup> September 2021** - Belair, Stubbs, Orange Hill, Touroma, Brighton & Belmont

**Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2021** - Arnos Vale, Victoria Village, Calder Ridge, Overland, Magnum, Spring & Fitz Hughes

**Thursday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2021** - Arnos Vale, Barrouallie, Peruvian Vale, Chateaubelair & London

Please take note of the following:

- Home and business owners in the named areas are reminded to keep their windows and doors open to allow the fog to take effect.
- Motorists are kindly asked to take caution.
- Persons who are suffering from any respiratory illnesses are kindly asked to take the necessary precautionary measures.
- Residents are also encouraged to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in their yard and to protect themselves from mosquito bites during the day.
- Please note adverse weather conditions can affect fogging operations.
