### **FOGGING SCHEDULE FOR 31<sup>ST</sup> AUGUST - 2<sup>ND</sup> SEPTEMBER 2021**

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to advise the general public that as part of the its mosquito control programme for the adult *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, the Insect Vector Control Unit will be conducting fogging operations in the following areas commencing at **5:00 pm** daily on the island of St. Vincent.

**Tuesday, 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021** - Green Hill, Retreat, Freeland, Three Rivers, South Rivers, New Grounds and Petit Bordel

**Wednesday, 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021** - Lodge Village, Queenbury, Carouth, Montique, South Rivers, New Grounds & Rose Bank

**Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2021** - Lodge Village, Penniston, Farm, Park Hill, New Grounds and Troumaca

Please take note of the following:

- Home and business owners in the named areas are reminded to keep their windows and doors open to allow the fog to take effect.
- Motorists are kindly asked to take caution.
- Persons who are suffering from any respiratory illnesses are kindly asked to take the necessary precautionary measures.
- Residents are also encouraged to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in their yard and to protect themselves from mosquito bites during the day.
- Please note adverse weather conditions can affect fogging operations.
