## FOGGING SCHEDULE FOR 19<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2021

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to advise the general public that as part of the its mosquito control programme for the adult *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, the Insect Vector Control Unit will be conducting fogging operations in the following areas commencing at **5:00** pm daily.

**Tuesday, 19<sup>th</sup> January 2021** – Barrouallie, Carrierre, Chateaubelair, Brighton, Calliaqua, Evesham, Enhams, New Adelphi, Mount Young & Chester Cottage.

**Wednesday, 20<sup>th</sup>January 2021** – Barrouallie, Collins, Coulls Hill, Diamond, Calliaqua, Glenside, McCarthy, Chapmans & Gorse

**Thursday, 21**<sup>st</sup> **January 2021** - Barrouallie, Spring Village, Diamond, Glen, Yambou, Argyle, Glamorgan, New Grounds & Byera .

Please take note of the following:

- Home and business owners in the named areas are reminded to keep their windows and doors open to allow the fog to eliminate the adult mosquitoes inside the home.
- Motorists are kindly asked to take caution.
- Persons who are suffering from any respiratory illnesses are kindly asked to take the necessary precautionary measures.
- Residents are also encouraged to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in their yard and to protect themselves from mosquito bites during the day.
- Please note adverse weather conditions can affect fogging operations.
