GLOBAL HEALTH FORUM EXAMINES BUILDING RESPONSE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

Ministers of Health and health officials from across the world convened in Taipei, Taiwan for the 2024 Global Health Forum.

The two-day meeting began on November 5 and will examine global solidarity, lessons learnt from the Covid-19 pandemic as well as buttressing responses to Public Health Emergencies.

The meeting also examined financing global health- new trends and challenges and building on digital innovations in health.

The Global Health and Welfare Forum is an annual event which has been one of the most important public health events in Asia and has been held for nineteen (19) consecutive years.

Since its inauguration in 2005, the forum has convened leaders from around the world in research, policy, and practice and to share ideas and experiences that address health and welfare challenges globally.

This year, the forum is being held under the theme "Developing Global Health: The Health Right for all".

St Vincent and the Grenadines is being represented by Minister of Health Hon. St Clair Prince, while there, Minister Prince will also have bilateral meetings with Taiwanese Ministers regarding continuing assistance with the new Acute Referral Hospital at ArnosVale.
